ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The environment is a common good of vital importance for people's well-being that we should take care of, both for us and for future generations.

Dragados, in the performance of its commitment to continuous improvement and extreme respect for the environment, demands that its worksites go beyond mere compliance with current legislation and, to do so, develops its activity taking on voluntary commitments based on the following principles:

- a) Plan the processes and carry out the works minimizing the environmental impact.*
- b) Contribute to the transition to a low-carbon economy by including climate change adaptation and mitigation measures in its activities.*
- c) Prevent pollution by reducing emissions of greenhouse gases and other gaseous pollutants, noise emissions and light pollution.*
- d) Take into account the life cycle of projects, promoting the use of sustainable building materials.*
- e) Promote the Circular Economy through adequate waste management, reducing waste generation, managing them properly and encouraging their reuse and recycling.*
- f) Implement measures to optimize water consumption and reduce the volume or danger of discharges.*
- g) Minimize the impact of our activity and our supply chain on biodiversity, including the commitment against deforestation.*
- h) Train our own staff and raise awareness among suppliers, clients and other stakeholders on environmental issues.*
- i) Consider those alternatives, both from clients and suppliers, that contribute to favor the environment.*
- j) Share experience and knowledge with other companies, institutions and social partners connected with the environment.*
- k) Communicate to stakeholders all relevant information on environmental performance.*

These principles should govern our actions in order to combine the company's activity, based on responsible and sustainable construction, with the environment that we need.
